Evaluation: Evaluation Report (ER)

Evaluation Criteria: Content

- eval** Memo of Transmittal is framed properly, provides appropriate context & justification for the project, provides a link to the screencast, & requests appropriate action regarding the project.
- eval** Title communicates the document's purpose & identifies the Object of Study (OoS).
- eval** Overview frames the report appropriately: introduces OoS; previews evaluation.
- eval** ER distills the purpose & essential features & functions of the OoS.
- eval** ER evaluates the qualities & characteristics of the OoS based on the author's experiences working with it this semester.
- eval** ER offers a final evaluation of the OoS.
- eval** ER presents a strong complement of images of the OoS in context of use.
- eval** ER content is well organized.
- eval** ER discussion supported well with appropriate evidence.

Evaluation Criteria: Design & Delivery

- eval** Memos of Transmittal meet format/layout expectations for the genre.
- eval** Screening document establishes & maintains a strong, consistent visual logic.
- eval** Screening document is presented in a professional screen design that effectively coordinates text, visual content.
- eval** Screening document is professionally framed on screen.
- eval** Presentation of content is consistently well paced & confidently delivered.
- eval** Screencast audio & video are clear & free of glitches or production problems.

Evaluation Criteria: Professionalism

- eval** Submission includes the required, properly labeled files in appropriate formats posted to the designated location.
- eval** Memo of Transmittal demonstrates appropriate professionalism & attention to detail.
- eval** ER screening doc demonstrates consistent professionalism & attention to detail.
- eval** ER screencast demonstrates consistent professionalism & attention to detail.
- eval** Presenter seems prepared, & maintains appropriate professionalism throughout the screencast.
- eval** Written & spoken content are grammatically sound, properly punctuated.
- eval** Written & spoken content are stylistically appropriate (economical, direct), & utilize audience-appropriate terminology.
- eval** Spoken content is stylistically appropriate (economical, direct), & utilizes audience-appropriate terminology.

Evaluation Criteria: Revision

- eval** Final submission demonstrates effective response to feedback on draft.
- eval** Final submission represents continued, effective development of content & refinement of design.
